



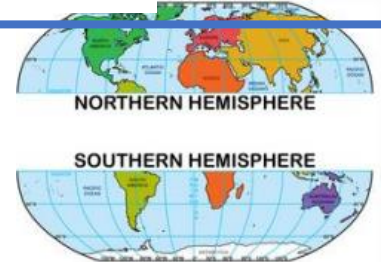
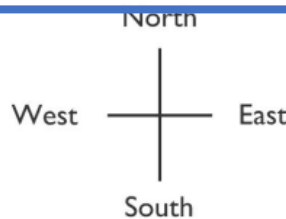

Continent	A large area of land.
Country	A large <u>expanse</u> of land within a Continent.
Ocean	A large area of <u>saline</u> water
Sea	A smaller, enclosed or partly enclosed saline water.
Submerged	Covered by water
Saline	Salty
Magma	Hot, <u>liquid</u> rock

The Southern Ocean surrounds Antarctica and is the coldest ocean.	Much of the ocean is covered with ice. The thickness of the ice depends of the Earth's temperatures.
