

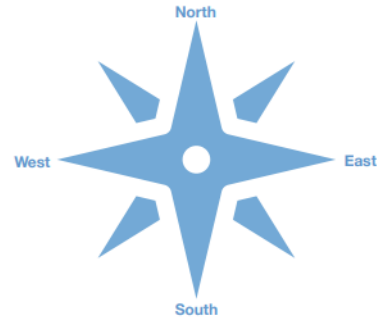

### Maps of the world

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Globe	A globe is a model of the Earth.
Map	A drawing of a place using lines and symbols.
Atlas	A collection of maps in a book.
Ariel view	A view from above
Compass rose	A compass printed on a map to show directions.
Map symbols	A picture or sign which represents something else.
Key	Helps us understand map symbols



People use a compass to help them position and follow a map properly. The four main points on a compass are North, East, South and West.



A key uses different symbols to help People locate specific places on a map.  
Here are just a few.



You can use a globe to locate the world's five oceans and seven continents.  
The seven continents are made of many different countries.

When planning a journey people can use a map to find the fastest and safest route. A map shows things such as paths, roads, rivers and railway lines.



Here is an ariel view image. Another name for an ariel view is called a 'bird's eye view'. Why do you think it is called a bird's eye view?
