









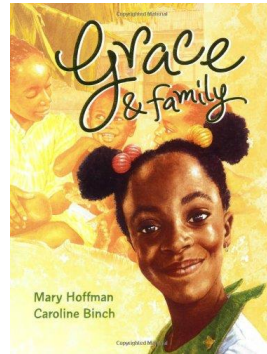
Reading Long-Term Plan 2022-2023

At Reynolds Academy, early reading is taught through systematic, synthetic phonics using Bug Club Phonics. Foundation Stage and Year 1 follow phonics pacing sheets to support the teaching of the 44 sounds. This phonetical understanding is then built upon through the use of Spelling Shed to support the knowledge of spelling patterns alongside phonics. As the children progress through the school, key skills are taught and developed through whole class guided reading linking with our English units of work. Teachers use the One Education reading gems to support the children to comprehend what they are reading. Each term or half term, the children focus on a different text as part of their guided reading lessons as outlined below. In addition to focusing on the texts below, children are exposed to non-fiction and poetry to further enhance and support their existing knowledge.
